MOTION NO. 10196

A MOTION requesting the Office of the Hearing Examiner to conduct a public hearing on extending the period of time to satisfy a pre-effective condition established at the time of a zoning reclassification.

FINDINGS:

- In 1995 an application was submitted for a zoning reclassification for property in the four corners area of Maple Valley.
- On June 23, 1995 the Hearing Examiner approved the 2. zoning reclassification, from R-12 to CB, subject to conditions(see Department of Development and Environmental Services File No. L94RZ001).
- One of the conditions listed in the Hearing Examiner's 3. recommendation was pre-effective, which required that a complete application for a building permit for development of the property for CB use would be obtained within two years following Metropolitan King County Council approval of the zoning reclassification.
- On July 17, 1995 the Metropolitan King County Council concurred with the Hearing Examiner's recommendation, and the zoning reclassification was approved subject to the conditions recommended by the Hearing Examiner.
- Pursuant to Ordinance 12196 a certificate of water availability is required for a complete application for a building permit.
- This property is within the Covington Water District 6. which currently has a moratorium on all certificates of water availability.

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A complete application for a building permit is not 7. feasible until the water moratorium is lifted. 2 realize the CB zoning that was granted to the property 3 owner in 1995, the building permit application must be 4 5 filed with the Department of Development and 6 Environmental Services by July 17, 1997. If this does not occur, the property owner would be required to submit 7 a new application for a rezone. 8 9 Additional time is needed to obtain a certificate of 10 8. water availability from Covington. 11 12 In accordance with K.C.C. 20.24.230, the Council may 13 9. extend the period for the conditions to be satisfied if 14 after a public hearing by the Hearing Examiner, the 15 Council finds an extension will be in the public 16 interest and the extension was requested by the 17 applicant within the initial time period. 18 19 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 20 The zoning reclassification file no. L94RZ001 shall hereby be 21 referred to the Office of the Hearing Examiner for a public 22 23 hearing on an extension of the period for the pre-effective 24 condition to be satisfied.
