A MOTION approving a landmark restoration project for the
Arts and Natural Resources Initiative-Suburban Arts and
Heritage Programs in accordance with Ordinance 11578.

WHEREAS, the King County landmarks and heritage commission is authorized by
Ordinance 11578 to administer suburban heritage projects, including landmark stabilization as
part of the County Council's Arts and Natural Resources Initiative, and

WHEREAS, in March of 1996, the King County landmarks and heritage commission
forwarded a recommendation to award grant funds for nine landmark restoration projects,
including \$25,000 for the restoration of the Harrington Log House, and

WHEREAS, Council motion 9841 approved grant awards for eight landmark
stabilization projects and delayed consideration of the \$25,000 grant recommended by the
King County landmarks and heritage commission for the restoration of the Harrington Log
House pending design review approval by the landmarks and heritage commission for the
moving and restoration of the house, and

WHEREAS, the King County landmarks and heritage commission voted on March 27,
1997 to approve a Certificate of Appropriateness for the moving and restoration of the house;

1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

2 Following notice and public hearing required by Section 147(f) of the Internal
3 Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, the executive is hereby authorized to allocate a total of
4 \$25,000 from the Suburban Arts and Heritage Component of the Arts and Natural Resources
5 Initiative for the restoration of the Harrington Log House.
