A MOTION appointing a committee to write a voters pamphlet statement for the November 4, 1997 general election regarding Ordinance 12850 providing for the submission to the electorate of King County, at a special election on November 4, 1997, a proposition imposing the levy of a general tax each year for six years beginning in 1998 at a rate of \$.29 or less for \$1,000 of assessed valuation for the provision of emergency medical services.

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for annual general elections held in King County, and

WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.090 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 12850 provides for submission to the voters on November 4, 1997 a proposition imposing the levy of a general tax each year for six years beginning in 1998 at a rate of \$.29 or less for \$1,000 of assessed valuation for the provision of emergency medical services;
