2 A MOTION appointing a committee to write a voters pamphlet
3 statement for the November 4, 1997 general election regarding
4 Ordinance 12845 proposing to amend the King County Charter
5 related to referendums on and initiative proposing ordinances which
6 are effective only in unincorporated areas of the county; amending
7 sections 230.40 and 230.50 of Article 2 of the Charter; and
8 submitting the same to the voters of the county for their ratification
9 or rejection at the November 1997 general election.

11 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local
12 voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for annual general
13 elections held in King County, and

14 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is
15 included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally
16 appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a
17 committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

18 WHEREAS, Ordinance 12845 provides for submission to the voters on November 4, 1997 a
19 proposition to amend the King County Charter related to referendums on and initiative proposing
20 ordinances which are effective only in unincorporated areas of the county; amending sections 230.40
21 and 230.50 of Article 2 of the Charter; and submitting the same to the voters of the county for their
22 ratification or rejection at the November 1997 general election;
