2 A MOTION appointing a committee to write a voters pamphlet  
3 statement for the November 4, 1997 general election regarding  
4 Ordinance 12848 proposing amendments to the King County Charter  
5 concerning ethics; creating an independent board of ethics; amending  
6 section 310 in Article 3 of the Charter; amending Article 8 of the  
7 Charter by adding new section 825; and submitting the same to the  
8 voters of the county for their ratification or rejection at the  
9 November 1997 general election.

11 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local  
12 voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for annual general  
13 elections held in King County, and

14 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is  
15 included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally  
16 appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a  
17 committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

18 WHEREAS, Ordinance 12848 provides for submission to the voters on November 4, 1997 a  
19 proposition amendments to the King County Charter concerning ethics; creating an independent  
20 board of ethics; amending section 310 in Article 3 of the Charter; amending Article 8 of the Charter  
21 by adding new sections 825; and submitting the same to the voters of the county for their ratification  
22 or rejection at the November 1997 general election;
