2 A MOTION approving landmark restoration projects for the Arts
3 and Natural Resources Initiative-Suburban Arts and Heritage
4 Projects in accordance with Ordinance 11578.

6 WHEREAS, the King County landmarks and heritage commission is authorized by
7 Ordinance 11578 to administer suburban heritage projects, including landmark restoration as part
8 of the county council's Arts and Natural Resources Initiative, and

9 WHEREAS, the landmarks and heritage commission has received three applications
10 requesting a total of \$74,271 from the Arts and Natural Resources Initiative - Suburban Arts and
11 Heritage program for landmark restoration projects, and

12 WHEREAS, a review panel of historic preservation professionals reviewed the
13 applications and made recommendations to the King County landmarks and heritage commission
14 as listed in Attachment A, and

15 WHEREAS, the recommendations for stabilization projects funding adhere to the
16 guidelines approved by the King County council in Motion 9514, and

17 WHEREAS, notice and public hearing are required before allocation of monies for
18 landmark stabilization projects that are intended to be reimbursed by proceeds of bonds to be
19 issued by King County;

20 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 Following notice and public hearing required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue
22 Code of 1986, and amended, the executive is hereby authorized to allocate a total of \$20,000 fro
