A MOTION expressing the importance of Washington State Legislature Second Substitute Senate Bill 6168 relating to temporary housing for migrant farm workers, and amending the 1998 state legislative program for King County.

WHEREAS, there is a significant shortage of suitable housing in Washington for both permanent resident and migrant farm workers, and

WHEREAS, in 1995, the Washington state legislature designated the department of health as the single state agency responsible for developing temporary worker housing, and

WHEREAS, the state building code was directed to develop a separate building code for temporary worker housing, and

WHEREAS, a technical advisory group completed the temporary worker building code and delivered it to the legislature in December 1996, and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 6168 requires the department of health to adopt a temporary worker building code, in conformance with the housing standards of the Washington Industrial Health and Safety Act (WISHA), and separate from the state version of the uniform building code, and

WHEREAS, the code must be the exclusive code applied to the construction, alteration or repair of temporary worker housing, and
