12 WHEREAS, the King County department of parks and recreation received twenty-
13 nine applications requesting \$1,027,942 from the second 1997 Youth Sports Facility Grant
14 cycle, and

15 WHEREAS, based on the criteria established by the King County council in
16 Motion 8854, the department of parks and recreation has made the following
17 recommendations, as listed in Attachment A;
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
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NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The King County executive is hereby authorized to allocate a total of \$524,312 for sixteen youth sports projects as listed in Attachment A.
