WHEREAS, Proposed Ordinance 98-290 relating to the adoption of the Regional
Wastewater Services Plan was referred to the regional water quality committee on May 11,
1998, and

WHEREAS, the regional water quality committee is in the process of reviewing
this important decision with great diligence and scrutiny, and

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.24.065 refers to the rules governing regional committees and
allow each regional committee one hundred twenty days to review referred legislation or
such other time as is jointly established between the council and the committee and is
confirmed in the form of a council motion, and,

WHEREAS, September 8, 1998 marks the one hundred and twentieth day of
referral of Proposed Ordinance 98-290, and

WHEREAS, KCC 1.24.065 allows regional committees to request additional time
for review of referred legislation by motion to the county council, and


WHEREAS, the regional water quality committee requires additional time to study and review the Regional Wastewater Services Plan before making its recommendation to the full council:

The regional water quality committee period of review of the Regional Wastewater Services Plan is extended until December 31, 1998.


