A MOTION relating to Summit Communications' request for approval of transfer of its King County cable television system to Millennium Digital Media Systems.

WHEREAS, Summit Communications, Inc. serves approximately 1,778 citizens of unincorporated King County, and

WHEREAS, the franchise agreement with Summit Communications expired on December 1, 1995, and

WHEREAS, and pursuant to K.C.C. 6.27A.220, Summit Communications continued to provide services after the expiration of the franchise on the same terms as the expired franchise, and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to the citizens served by Summit Communications to have a new franchise agreement that required upgraded service provisions, and

WHEREAS, Summit Communications has requested approval of the transfer of its system to Millennium Digital Media Systems.
