A MOTION welcoming the World Trade Organization to King County for the Seattle Round of talks on international trade.

WHEREAS, King County supports several key local organizations whose mission it is to expand international trade, and

WHEREAS, the King County area has more than thirty sister county, sister city and sister port relationships to encourage closer cultural and economic ties with the world community, and

WHEREAS, there are more than twenty consulates and several foreign trade offices in King County, and

WHEREAS, King County is home to many international residents, foreign students and local citizens of diverse cultural backgrounds speaking nearly a hundred languages, and

WHEREAS, the arrival of the World Trade Organization offers the unique opportunity to learn about the WTO and its relationship to other countries of the world, and

WHEREAS, trade laws should not only empower workers and consumers but protect the environment, respect sovereignty and foster sustainable, broad-based economic development, and

WHEREAS, the goal of a strong global economy should be to support basic human rights and raise the living standards of the population around the world,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The council hereby welcomes the World Trade Organization and its delegates to King County for an important global event.
