MOTION NO. 10751

A MOTION renaming North Wind Weir Park to Cecil Moses Memorial Park in honor of a past Muckleshoot Tribal Leader.

WHEREAS, King County is interested in appropriately naming its parks for their geographically prominent feature or location, its place in history or to honor its current or past citizens, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes the importance of this park site to the historic culture of the Native American tribes of this area, and

WHEREAS, King County entered into an agreement with the Muckleshoot Tribe on August 29, 1995, and agreed, in part, to propose to the King County council to rename the North Wind Weir Park the Cecil Moses Memorial Park.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: that the

currently named North Wind Weir Park now be officially known as Cecil Moses Memorial

Park.

PASSED by a vote of 11 to 0 this 7th day of September, 1999.
