RESOLUTION NO. 99-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISSAOUAH. **CALLING** WASHINGTON, FOR ELECTION TO BE **QUESTION** HELD ON THE ANNEXATION OF A PORTION OF THE NORTH ISSAOUAH AN UNINCORPORATED ANNEXATION AREA. **AREA** CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH.

WHEREAS, in October, 1998, the City of Issaquah selected a consultant to require study of the feasibility of annexing all or portions of the North Issaquah annexation area; and

WHEREAS, the area proposed for annexation is within the Issaquah Planning area, the Issaquah School District and the Greater Issaquah Community; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 1999, the City Council adopted the scope of work for a study on the feasibility of the annexation and authorizing the Mayor to establish an annexation Task Force to participate in development of the study and to carry out a public involvement program; and

WHEREAS, the Feasibility Study and other available information indicate that levels of all public services provided to the annexation area and to the City as it exists today would not decline as a result of annexation, and that the best interests and general welfare of the City would be served by the annexation; NOW, THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to RCW 35A.14.015, the City of Issaquah hereby calls for an election on November 2, 1999, to submit a proposal for annexation to the electorate of a certain

area commonly known as the North Issaquah Annexation Area.

Section 2. The boundaries of the area to be annexed are hereby described in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

Section 3. The number of voters residing within the area to be annexed, as nearly as can be estimated, is _1,390_.

Section 4. The City of Issaquah hereby agrees to pay the cost of the annexation election.

Section 5. A proposition shall also be submitted to the electorate of the territory sought to be annexed specifying that all property within the area annexed shall, upon annexation, be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as the property within the City of Issaquah is assessed and taxed to pay for the then outstanding indebtedness of the City.

Section 6. Pursuant to RCW 35A.14.330, proposed zoning for the area to be annexed shall be established to be effective upon annexation.

Section 7. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the King County Council and with the Washington State Boundary Review Board for King County.



City of Issaquah Proposed Annexation Legal Description (Revised: 9/2/99)

Those portions of Sections 16, 21, 22, 27 and 28, Township 24 North, Range 6 East W.M. King County, Washington described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the West line of the Burlington Northern Right of Way in the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, with the East/West centerline of said Southwest Quarter,

Thence East along said East/West centerline and the East/West centerline of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 16 to the Northwest corner of Tract "D" of the Plat of Sammamish 95, recorded in Volume 141 of Plats, pages 21 through 25, records of King County, Washington:

Thence Easterly along said South margin and the Easterly extension thereof to the East margin of Issaquah-Pine Lake Road;

Thence Southeasterly along said East margin of Issaquah-Pine Lake Road to a point of intersection with the Northwesterly margin of SE Issaquah-Fall

City Road, as conveyed to King County under Recording Numbers 9807070556 and 9807070557, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Northeasterly along said Northwesterly margin to its intersection with the North/South centerline of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 22;

Thence South along said North/South centerline to its intersection with the Easterly line of the Plat of Vaughn Hill Add. As recorded in Volume 102 of Plats, Pages 99-100, Records of King County, Washington;

Thence Southeasterly along said Easterly line to the South line of said Plat;

Thence West along the South line of said Plat and the South line extended to the East margin of the Issaquah-Fall City Road;

Thence Southerly along the Easterly line of said short plat and its Southerly extension to its intersection with the South margin of Black Nugget Road.

Thence Easterly along the South margin of Black Nugget Road to the Northeasterly corner of Parcel "C" of KCLLA S90M0217 as recorded under King County recording number 9706230329;

Thence South 30°31'17" West a distance of 416.07 feet, more or less, along the East line of said KCLLA to the Southeast corner of said KCLLA;

Thence South 61°09'11" West a distance of 421.30 feet to the Southwest corner said KCLLA;

Thence South 28°50'49" East a distance of 263 feet more or less to an intersection with the East/West centerline of the Southeast Quarter of Section 22, Township 24 North, Range 6 East;

Thence East along said East/West centerline of said Quarter section to a point 240 feet West of the East line of said Section 22;

Thence Northeasterly to a point on the East line of said Section 22 which is 340 feet North of the intersection of the East/West centerline of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 22;

Thence East along said South line of Section 16 to its intersection with the West margin of the Burlington Northern RR R/W;

Thence Northwesterly along said West margin of the railroad R/W to it's intersection with the East/West centerline of the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, Township 24 North, Range 6 East and the true point of beginning.
