WASHINGTON STATE COURT OF APPEALS RELATING TO COURT OF APPEALS SECURITY

This is an Interlocal Agreement between King County, a home rule charter county and political subdivision of the State of Washington, hereinafter referred to as the "County" and the Washington State Court of Appeals, Division One, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, hereinafter referred to as the "Court".

1. County Responsibilities.

The County will provide the following services:

- 1.1 Services. Effective July 1, 1999, the County will provide court security services at the Washington State Court of Appeals. The County will provide one security officer to cover the Oral Argument Calendar and all Fridays, excluding holidays. Responsibilities shall include screening of all persons attending open court sessions for weapons. Additional services will be provided upon request and mutual consent of the parties at the rate established herein.
- 1.2 Support Services. The County will provide support services including recruitment and hiring of new officers, training for all newly hired security officers, and providing uniform and equipment through its quartermaster system. The Court will provide metal detection equipment as deemed necessary.
- 1.3 Facilities Critique. The County will provide input as requested to security-related design issues in the Court facilities.

2. Staffing and Equipment.

- 2.1 Management. The County shall govern control of personnel, standards of performance, discipline and all other aspects of performance.
- 2.2 Personnel. Security will be provided by the King County Court Security Officers who obtain a special commission from the Sheriff's Office.
- 2.3 Uniform and Equipment. Security officers will be furnished King County Sheriff's Office police uniforms, and will be provided equipment through the KCSO quartermaster system.
