A MOTION designating nonprofit organizations and agencies to receive surplus vans from the King County fleet.

WHEREAS, the provision of cargo and passenger vans to nonprofit organizations who serve citizens in need provides a significant public benefit, and

WHEREAS, these nonprofit organizations have limited resources and transportation options, and

WHEREAS, the King County council amended Ordinance 12045 and K.C.C. 4.56.100 to allow for the donation of personal and real property in Ordinance 12989, and

WHEREAS, the King County council established policy direction for the transportation and distribution of food to citizens in need in Motion 10186, and

WHEREAS, the King County council recognized that there are many nonprofit organizations that need assistance in transporting people, goods and materials in order to fulfil their missions, and

WHEREAS, the King County council established policies guiding the distribution of surplus property to nonprofit organizations serving King County residents in Motion 10477, and

19 WHEREAS, the executive has conducted a selection process to identify agencies

20 whose use of a donated van would be consistent with council intent and criteria:

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 The donation of surplus cargo or passenger vans to each of the following agencies

23 is hereby approved:

- 24 Low Income Housing Institute (LIHI)
- 25 Lutheran Alliance to Create Housing (LATCH)
- 26 Fremont Public Association (FPA)
- 27 Vashon - Maury Community Food Bank


