5 WHEREAS, the King County public art commission is required by Ordinance
6 12089 to present for approval by the King County council an annual program plan which
7 identifies and describes art projects to be initiated during the next budget year, and

8 WHEREAS, the King County public art commission has prepared a document
9 entitled 2000 Public Art Program Annual Plan describing public art projects and program
10 activities in response to Ordinance 12089, and

11 WHEREAS, the King County council finds that the 2000 Public Art Program
12 Annual Plan is in conformity with the council's intent for use of designated Public Art
13 Program funds;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 The attached 2000 Public Art Program Annual Plan is hereby approved if the
16 Portable Collection Purchases project, project number 662168, on page 14 of the *Public*
17 *Art 2000 Annual Plan* is deleted, and the \$40,000 budget is used to fund a new project, to

18 be proposed by the Public Art Commission, that includes the following components:


- 19 A) The involvement of students;
- 20 B) The instruction of a practical application, for example, graphic illustration,
21 website development or computer animation;
- 22 C) The opportunity to showcase artwork created by students in collaboration with
23 artists in county facilities or on the county website; and
- 24 D) The accessibility of the artwork by county employees and the general public.


