1           A MOTION directing the open space citizens oversight  
2           committee to draft project eligibility criteria for the  
3           allocation of conservation futures tax revenues as adopted in  
4           Ordinance 13717 for transmittal to the council on or before  
5           August 1, 2000.

6           WHEREAS, conservation futures tax revenues are collected by King County and  
7           are dedicated exclusively for the acquisition of open space lands, and

8           WHEREAS, the King County council adopted Ordinance 13717 authorizing  
9           funding allocation procedures for conservation futures tax revenues, and

10          WHEREAS, the open space citizens oversight committee is responsible for  
11          reviewing applications for conservation futures tax revenues and making  
12          recommendations to the executive and the council on projects to be funded, and

13          WHEREAS, open space lands purchased with conservation futures tax revenues  
14          must meet county open space criteria specified in Ordinance 13717, and

15          WHEREAS, the open space citizen oversight committee is responsible for  
16          ranking applications based on the open space criteria specified in Ordinance 13717;


17          NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18           The open space citizens oversight committee is directed, as its first order of  
19 business, to draft project eligibility criteria including definitions of the open space criteria  
20 specified in Ordinance 13717 for transmittal to the council on or before August 1, 2000.  
21 The transmittal shall be accompanied by a motion approving the project eligibility  
22 criteria.
