1 A MOTION to name a stream, located in southeast 2 unincorporated King County, "Lions Run." 3 4 5 WHEREAS, an unnamed stream located in southeast King County is a tributary 6 of the Cedar river, and 7 WHEREAS, the stream is a groundwater-fed stream that flows twelve months a 8 year and is approximately two thousand feet long, one and one-half feet deep and four 9 feet wide, and 10 WHEREAS, the stream serves as spawning ground for sockeye salmon, and 11 WHEREAS, the Renton Lions Club uses the stream to conduct environmental . 12 education programs, and 13 WHEREAS, in 1996, the Renton Lions Club and the King County water and land 14 resources division enhanced the riparian zone along the stream to improve spawning

16	WHEREAS, a proposal to name the stream "Lions Run" was submitted to the
17	Washington State Board on Geographic Names by the Renton Lions Club on March 28,
