A MOTION appointing a committee to write the voters pamphlet statement for the November 7, 2000 general election regarding Ordinance 13947 providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County, at the general election on November 7, 2000, of a proposition authorizing the county to issue its general obligation bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$193,130,000 or so much thereof as may be issued under the laws governing the indebtedness of counties, for the purpose of providing funds to pay for seismic and public health and safety improvements for Harborview Medical Center.

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29.81A RCW for elections held in King County, and

WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 13947 provides for the submission to the qualified electors of King County, at the general election on November 7, 2000, of a proposition authorizing the county to issue its general obligation bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$193,130,000 or so much thereof as may be issued under the laws governing the indebtedness of counties, for the purpose of providing funds to pay for seismic and public health and safety improvements for Harborview Medical Center.




