3 election regarding Ordinance 13931 providing for the
4 submission to the qualified electors of King County at a
5 special election to be held in King County on November 7,

7 use tax for the operation, maintenance and capital needs of
8 King County Metro public transportation, which includes
9 the accessible services and vanpool programs.

12 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
13 local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29.81A RCW for
14 elections held in King County, and

15 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction
16 that is included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction
17 shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the

18 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,
19 and

20 WHEREAS, Ordinance 13931 provides for the submission to the qualified
21 electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on November 7,
22 2000, of a proposition authorizing an additional sales and use tax for the operation,
23 maintenance and capital needs of King County Metro public transportation, which
24 includes the accessible services and vanpool programs;




