2001-0150.1 Sponsors Nickels Proposed No. 1 A MOTION authorizing the donation of King County 2 sheriff's office's surplus and unusable items to the Seattle 3 Metropolitan Police Museum. 4 5 6 WHEREAS, the King County sheriff's office owns surplus and unusable items 7 such as obsolete uniforms, bulletproof vests, badges, patches and other miscellaneous 8 equipment of little or no monetary value, and 9 WHEREAS, the items for donation would normally be destroyed or sold in bulk 10 at an auction to lower administrative costs and separating them out for separate auctions 11 would not be cost effective for the county, and 12 WHEREAS, the items for donation would be of notable historical value which 13 would promote, document, demonstrate and depict the history, culture and technological 14 transitions of the King County sheriff's office, and 15 WHEREAS, the Seattle Metropolitan Police Museum's mission is to collect, 16 preserve and exhibit artifacts and archival material significant to the history of law

enforcement in Seattle and King County, and
