A MOTION supporting effective long-term planning for public transportation amenities, including parking, in downtown Kent.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent's downtown strategic plan is designed to provide infrastructure, economic opportunity, and urban amenities that match Kent's central location and high quality of life, and

WHEREAS, innovative transit oriented development of the County's James Street
Park and Ride Lot, the City's Municipal Parking Lot and the Borden site can help achieve
the City's economic development goals and provide substantial benefits to Sound Transit
and the County government, including Metro Transit, and

WHEREAS, the County's Regional Justice Center and the new Sounder

Commuter Rail Station are two catalysts for new economic development in downtown

18	WHEREAS, the City of Kent, King County and Sound Transit are cooperating on
19	the development of public transportation facilities that are convenient for bus, commuter
20	rail and vanpool riders, and
21	WHEREAS, the potential for successful transit oriented development in
22	downtown Kent is so great that long-term planning for public transportation amenities,
23	including parking, is essential to ensure that the needs of transit riders can be met not just
24	in the near term but in the next twenty years and beyond,

The City of Kent, King County and Sound Transit are encouraged and requested

to work cooperatively to ensure that planning for downtown Kent addresses the long-term

as well as short-term needs for economic development and public transportation

amenities, including parking.
