 WHEREAS, Operation Lookout is thoroughly impressed with the services
13 provided by the sheriff's office child find unit and wishes to support their efforts in this
14 time of tight budgetary concerns, and

 WHEREAS, Operation Lookout voluntarily, without coercion or inducement, is
16 offering to cover the registration fees and lodging costs for attendance by a sheriff's office
17 child find unit detective, with an estimated cost of three hundred sixty-five dollars, and

19 in the public's interest and is a general offer to the King County sheriff's office, and

20 WHEREAS, this donation is intended neither to influence a particular county
21 action, nor to affect the performance of official duties and responsibilities by King

26 The King County sheriff's office is authorized to accept a donation of



Motion 11199 was introduced on 4/2/01 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 5/14/01, by the following vote:


