2	of registration fees and lodging costs from Operation
3	Lookout for the sheriff's office attendance at a Canadian

7	WHEREAS, the King County sheriff's office operates a child find unit to locate
8	missing children, and
9	WHEREAS, Operation Lookout, a private nonprofit organization with no
10	contractual relationship with the county, is hosting a symposium in Victoria, Canada in
11	April 2001, and
12	WHEREAS, Operation Lookout is thoroughly impressed with the services
13	provided by the sheriff's office child find unit and wishes to support their efforts in this
14	time of tight budgetary concerns, and
15	WHEREAS, Operation Lookout voluntarily, without coercion or inducement, is
16	offering to cover the registration fees and lodging costs for attendance by a sheriff's office
17	child find unit detective, with an estimated cost of three hundred sixty-five dollars, and

18	WHEREAS, this donation will legitimately enhance the county's ability to serve
19	in the public's interest and is a general offer to the King County sheriff's office, and
20	WHEREAS, this donation is intended neither to influence a particular county
21	action, nor to affect the performance of official duties and responsibilities by King
22	County sheriff's deputies, and
23	WHEREAS, King County government is a charitable organization as defined by
24	the federal Internal Revenue Service and King County as an entity can accept gifts;
25	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
26	The King County sheriff's office is authorized to accept a donation of

registration fees and lodging costs for an April 2001 Canadian symposium to benefit the child find unit.
