



Minutes of March 20, 2001 Meeting

ACTION ITEM: JEM Studios-Request for Cultural Facilities Emergency Funds

Debra Twersky reported that JEM Studios, an artist collective developing artist live/work space in Georgetown, submitted an application for Cultural Facilities Emergency Funds. The building will include artist studios and living areas, as well as ground floor retail space, public exhibition space, and a small performance space. The group has successfully applied for funds from South Seattle Downtown Association and the Seattle Department of Neighborhoods.

Their request to King County is for \$15,000 to provide new hot and cold water lines to the studios and common areas. At present a portion of the facility is without hot water due to unexpected problems with the water supply lines. The Hotel/Motel Committee recommended to the Arts Commission that JEM Studios be awarded \$7,500 in funding, contingent upon receipt of a specific written bid for plumbing work.

MOTION: It was moved that the Arts Commission accept the recommendation of the Hotel/Motel Committee and award \$7,500 to JEM Studios from the Cultural Facilities Emergency Fund. This motion was approved by a vote of 5-0-0 (motion by Kristen Webb/second by Jason Everett).
