1 A MOTION authorizing the executive to accept a donation
2 of canine ballistic vests to the King County sheriff's office in
3 support of the canine unit.

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WHEREAS, the King County sheriff's office operates a canine unit to aid in
7 locating suspects, thereby enhancing public safety, both as a deterrent and as a tool in
8 apprehension, and

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WHEREAS, Lynnwood Veterinary Center, a private business with no contractual
11 relationship with the county, recently conducted a public fundraiser to provide canine
12 ballistic vests to various local law enforcement agencies, and

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WHEREAS, Lynnwood Veterinary Center understands the need for law
15 enforcement canine ballistic vest protection, and

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WHEREAS, Lynnwood Veterinary Center voluntarily, without coercion or
inducement, wishes to donate up to seven canine ballistic vests to the canine unit, and

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16 WHEREAS, this donation will legitimately enhance the county's ability to serve
17 in the public's interest and is a general offer to the King County sheriff's office canine
18 unit, and

19 WHEREAS, this donation is intended neither to influence a particular county
20 action, nor to affect the performance of official duties and responsibilities by King
21 County sheriff's deputies, and

22 WHEREAS, King County government is a charitable organization as defined by
23 the federal Internal Revenue Service and King County as an entity can accept gifts;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


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25 The King County sheriff's office is authorized to accept a donation of up to seven
