2	management of county property within the Belmondo
3	Reach Extension along the Cedar river.

6	WHEREAS, the King County department of transportation owns a 7.75 acre
7	parcel of land within the Belmondo Reach Extension,
8	WHEREAS, the county property within the Belmondo Reach Extension includes
9	one thousand three hundred feet along the Cedar river;
10	WHEREAS, the county property contains many natural resource attributes and
11	has a high natural resource value;
12	WHEREAS, the Belmondo Reach Extension has the highest habitat quality of any
13	location along the lower twenty-two miles of the Cedar river and the acquisition of this
14	property is considered the highest priority within the Cedar river legacy program;
15	WHEREAS, the county property provides ideal mainstem riverine habitat for
16	chinook, as well as coho, steelhead, sockeye and resident trout;
