7                   to administer cultural facilities, and

8                   WHEREAS, the King County arts commission received an application from  
9                   Town Hall Seattle requesting assistance from the 2001 cultural facilities program  
10                  emergency and unforeseen opportunity fund to repair damage caused by the Nisqually  
11                  Earthquake, and

12                  WHEREAS, a committee of the arts commission and community representatives  
13                  reviewed the application and made a recommendation to the King County arts  
14                  commission, as listed in Attachment A, and

15                  WHEREAS, the King County arts commission approved the review panel's  
16                  recommendation, and

17           WHEREAS, the recommendation for arts cultural facilities program funding  
18 adheres to the guidelines and financial plan policies approved by the King County  
19 council in Motion 8797, and

20           WHEREAS, the financial plan included as Attachment B has been revised to  
21 indicate actual hotel/motel tax revenue for 2000, and

22           WHEREAS, the financial plan supports cultural facilities funding:

24           The executive is hereby authorized to allocate a total of \$7,500 for one arts

25 cultural facilities project as listed in Attachment A.



**ACTION ITEM: Arts Facilities Emergency Funding Request:**

Mark Johnson reviewed a request for funding to the Arts Cultural Facilities Emergency Funding Program by Town Hall Seattle. Funds would provide repair of interior plaster and exterior terra cotta ornamentation damaged in the February earthquake. The proposal asks for \$10,000 as part of a \$22,000 project. The Hotel/Motel committee reviewed this request and recommends \$7,500 be provided for the project. Mark described the committee's analysis of the overall project. He noted that our funding would match a private donor's gift, and would fund all actual construction costs of the project.

MOTION: It was moved that the Arts Commission accept the Hotel/Motel committee's recommendation to provide \$7,500.00 to Town Hall Seattle to fund repair of plaster and terra cotta earthquake damage. Motion approved 7-0-0. (Motion by Steve Lorian/Second by Jason Everett).
