June 19, 2001

ACTION ITEM: Arts Facilities Emergency Funding Request:

Mark Johnson reviewed a request for funding to the Arts Cultural Facilities Emergency Funding Program by Town Hall Seattle. Funds would provide repair of interior plaster and exterior terra cotta ornamentation damaged in the February earthquake. The proposal asks for \$10,000 as part of a \$22,000 project. The Hotel/Motel committee reviewed this request and recommends \$7,500 be provided for the project. Mark described the committee's analysis of the overall project. He noted that our funding would match a private donor's gift, and would fund all actual construction costs of the project.

MOTION: It was moved that the Arts Commission accept the Hotel/Motel committee's recommendation to provide \$7,500.00 to Town Hall Seattle to fund repair of plastser and terra cotta earthquake damage. Motion approved 7-0-0. (Motion by Steve Lerian/Second by Jason Everett).
