Proposed No. 2001-0481.3 **Sponsors** Fimia and Phillips 1 A MOTION related to the transfer of retired vanpool vans to 2 non-profit organizations and local governments to meet the 3 needs of low-income, elderly, disabled and young county citizens. 4 5 6 7 WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its citizens to increase their 8 mobility options, reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation and 9 support a growing economy, and 10 WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to groups serving individuals with 11 limited resources and mobility options will support those goals and provide significant 12 public benefits, and WHEREAS, high quality passenger vans retaining substantial value and utility are 13 14 periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred 15 16 retired vans to agencies serving low-income, elderly, disabled and young people, and

17	WHEREAS, the council provided for the transfer of twenty-six additional vans in
18	the 2001 Metro transit division budget;
