12	most significant salmon-bearing streams in King (County, and has a proven record of
13	leading and participating in environmental protect	ion and habitat enhancement efforts

15	WHEREAS, King County Comprehensive	Plan Policy R-105 recognizes
16	resource-based cottage industries and the growing	and selling of horticultural products,

18	WHEREAS, cottage industries such as the Classic Nursery provide for the	
19	growing and sales of horticultural products to rural residents, and	
20	WHEREAS, King County Comprehensive Plan Policy R-106 recognizes and	
21	supports cottage industries that provide services to rural residents and that are part of the	
22	traditional rural economic activities and lifestyles found in the Rural Areas of King	
23	County, and	
24	WHEREAS, resource-related cottage industries such as the Classic Nursery on	
25	Avondale Road, are key components of maintaining a sound and healthy rural economy	
26	and are part of the very fabric of rural life, and	
27	WHEREAS, landscape design consultations are a logical extension of the services	
28	provide to buyers of horticultural product sold by a cottage industry such as Classic	
29	Nursery, and	
30	WHEREAS, such consultation services do not constitute an inappropriate	
31	extension of urban services if the consultations are limited to office or administrative	
32	functions and no equipment used for the installation of landscape materials off-site is	
33	kept on the premises;	
34	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:	
35	That the King County council hereby supports the activities of resource-based	
36	cottage industries such as Classic Nursery and the provision of design consultation
