WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council's redistricting process will
6 result in boundary changes to certain electoral districts that likely will require at least
7 technical amendments to the King County District Court Districting Plan, and

WHEREAS, annexations, incorporations and establishment of new municipal
9 courts has affected the number and distribution of cases among the various district courts
10 since the last substantive changes in judicial electoral district boundaries, and

WHEREAS, King County's serious current expense budget problems necessitate
12 organizing all operations of county government to achieve optimum efficiencies, and

WHEREAS, members of the King County district court districting committee,
14 members of the King County district court or members of the metropolitan King County
15 council may wish to consider amendments to the plan that might improve efficiencies in
16 court operations, and

17 WHEREAS, RCW 3.38.040 authorizes county legislative authorities to convene
18 the district court districting committees for the purpose of amending districting plans;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 The King County district court districting committee is hereby convened for the
21 purpose of amending the districting plan.

22 Its first meeting is hereby scheduled to be held on Thursday, January 10, 2002,
23 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the Southwest Conference Room, 12th Floor, King
24 County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington.

25 Although by law the committee must submit its proposed amendments to the
26 districting plan to the council by no later than March 15, 2002, the council respectively
27 requests that the committee submit its proposed amendments by the end of January in the



Motion 11336 was introduced on 10/29/01 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 12/3/01, by the following vote:


