A MOTION recognizing the critical importance of the 1 2 Alaskan Way viaduct, recognizing its unstable condition, 3 and calling for its replacement in the shortest possible time. 4 5 WHEREAS, the Alaskan Way viaduct was constructed in the 1950s, and 6 7 WHEREAS, the Alaskan Way viaduct is a major urban highway through the Puget Sound area, and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Alaskan Way viaduct route is a critical arterial for the movement 10 of goods through the Port of Seattle, and 11 WHEREAS, the Alaskan Way viaduct route is a critical roadway for 12 manufacturers in the Duwamish industrial corridor, and 13 WHEREAS, the Alaskan Way viaduct route also provides critical local links to 14 West Seattle, as well as between north and south Seattle, and 15 WHEREAS, growth and development have caused the Alaskan Way viaduct to 16 carry increasing commuter traffic loads, currently resulting in hundreds of thousands of

18	WHEREAS, the Nisqually earthquake damaged the Alaskan Way viaduct and
19	raised safety concerns, and
20	WHEREAS, failure to replace the Alaskan Way viaduct could result in significant
21	economic dislocation and loss of life and;
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
23	The council calls on the state of Washington and the city of Seattle to replace the
24	Alaskan Way viaduct with all possible speed.
25	The council further offers its encouragement and counsel in finding the most
26	appropriate solution to replace the viaduct.
