6	WHEREAS, the Pierce County Alliance was awarded a grant from the United
7	States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS),
8	and
9	WHEREAS, the grant is for the purpose of providing a program to address the
10	epidemic of clandestine methamphetamine production and related social-economic
11	problems statewide, and
12	WHEREAS, the Pierce County Alliance and King County feel methamphetamine
13	production has reached epidemic growth that has outstripped state and local resources,
14	and
15	WHEREAS, chemicals and waste products associated with the production of
16	methamphetamine pose significant environmental hazards and health threats to citizens of
17	King County, and

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18	WHEREAS, the county wishes to avail itself of a portion of the grant
19	funds obligated by the COPS office;
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
21	The county executive is authorized to execute an interagency agreement,
22	substantially in the form attached to this motion, for the purpose of providing a focused,
23	comprehensive and proactive approach to aggressively attack the methamphetamine
24	problem in King County.

#### AGREEMENT BETWEEN PIERCE COUNTY ALLIANCE AND KING COUNTY

2002-048

THIS AGREEMENT, is made and entered into by and between the Pierce County Alliance, hereinafter referred to as "PCA", and King County, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

IT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS AGREEMENT to provide services for the Washington State Methamphetamine Initiative as outlined in the attached Exhibit A. The funding source for this agreement is the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services; CFDA No. 16.710.

IT IS, THEREFORE, MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

#### STATEMENT OF WORK

Contractor shall furnish the necessary personnel, equipment, material and/or service(s) and otherwise do all things necessary for or incidental to the performance of the work set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All rights and obligations of the parties to this Agreement shall be subject to and governed by the Special Terms and Conditions contained in the text of this Agreement.

#### PERIQD OF PERFORMANCE

Subject to its other provisions, the period of performance of this Agreement shall be July 1, 2001 to April 30,2002, unless extended by written agreement or terminated sooner as provided herein.

#### BILLING PROCEDURE

PCA shall reimburse Contractor upon receipt of property executed vouchers, Exhibit B, to the maximum amount as indicated in Exhibit A. All claims for payment must be submitted to PCA within 30 days after the end of the period of performance.

#### NONDISCRIMINATION

In the performance of this Agreement, both parties shall comply with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 USC 200d); Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 USC 794); Chapter 49.60 Revised Code of Washington; and Title I of the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 USC 12111-12117), as now or hereafter amended. Both parties shall not discriminate on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, marital status, age, creed, Vletnam-era and disabled status, or the presence of any sensory, mental, or physical handicap.

#### RECORDS MAINTENANCE

Both parties to this Agreement shall each maintain books, records, documents and other evidence which sufficiently and property reflect all direct and indirect costs expended by either party in the performance of the scope of work and consistent with State of Washington accounting practices. These records shall be subject to inspection, review or audit by personnel of both parties. Both parties shall retain all books, records, documents, and other material relevant to this Agreement for three (3) years after expiration.

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#### INDEMNIFICATION

Each party shall defend, protect and hold harmless the other party from and against all claims, suits and/or actions arising from any negligent or intentional act or omission of that party's employees, agents, and/or authorized subcontractor(s) while performing this Agreement.

#### AGREEMENT ALTERATIONS AND AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of the parties. Such amendments shall not be binding unless they are in writing and signed by personnel authorized to bind each of the parties.

#### TERMINATION

Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days' written notification to the other party. If this Agreement is so terminated, the terminating party shall be liable only for performance in accordance with the terms of this Agreement for performance prior to the effective date of termination.

#### DISPUTES

In the event that a dispute arises under this Agreement, it shall be determined in the following manner:

PCA shall appoint one member to the Dispute Board. Contractor shall appoint one member to the Dispute Board. PCA and the Contractor shall jointly appoint an additional member to the Dispute Board. The Dispute Board shall evaluate the dispute and make a determination of the dispute. The determination of the Dispute Board shall be final and binding on the parties hereto. However, this process will not apply to dispute arising under the indemnification section of this agreement.

# SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The contractor agrees to the conditions placed upon these funds by the funding source as they may bear upon the contractor as subgrantee. These conditions are numbered one through fourteen under "Conditions of Grant Award" attached to award number 2001CKWX0177.

#### ALL WRITINGS CONTAINED HEREIN

This Agreement contains all the terms and conditions agreed upon by the parties. No other understandings, oral or otherwise, regarding the subject matter of this Agreement shall be deemed to exist or to bind any of the parties hereto.
