



**1. Renton Civic Theatre (RCT)** **Award: \$4,000.00**

 Incorporated: 1987  
 2001 Operating Budget: \$383,398

**Mission:** To provide quality, affordable entertainment for the South King County community through a diverse annual performance series.

**Project Description:** Replacement of boiler in the RCT building.

**Project budget:** \$19,250

**Request amount:** \$19,250

**Comments:**

The panel supported Renton Civic Theatre and recognized their immediate need to replace this failed piece of equipment. The Theatre's long standing commitment to their community and relatively large number of subscribers was noted. The panel felt that RCT should seek other community partners for this project and that a partial award from King County should provide them with a basis for soliciting support from other donors.

**2. Empty Space Theatre** **Award: \$7,000.00**

 Incorporated: 1971  
 2001 Operating Budget: \$1,093,156

**Mission:** The Empty Space strives to make theatre an event – bold, provocative, celebratory – bringing audiences and artists to a common ground through an uncommon experience.

**Project Description:** Replacement of van used as sole source of transportation between the theatre in Fremont and the scene shop located in the International District.

**Project budget:** \$14,550

**Request amount:** \$14,550

**Comments:**

The committee supported Empty Space's critical need for a vehicle used daily during the production season to move scenery, props and other equipment between two locations. Funds will be used to purchase a good quality used van.
