1                   A MOTION authorizing the chair of the council to enter an  
2                   extension of an existing contract for services to represent

7                   WHEREAS, the county is a subdivision of the state of Washington, and

8                   WHEREAS, as a result the county's services, operations and finances are to a  
9                   significant extent controlled by the laws of the state and the federal government, and

10                  WHEREAS, actions of the United States Congress will affect the county's  
11                  services, operations and finances, and

12                  WHEREAS, the grants, proposals and actions of the federal executive branch will  
13                  affect the delivery of services to the citizens of King County, and

14                  WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of the county for the county to  
15                  have representation before the United States Congress and the federal administration on a  
16                  broad range of complex issues, and

17           WHEREAS, a competitive procurement process led to the selection of the  
18 Ferguson Group for this contract and the satisfactory provision of services for the past  
19 two years, and

20           WHEREAS, the contract authorizes extension for a third and final year under the  
21 existing contract originally approved by approved by Motion 11334 and this extension is  
22 in the best interests of King County;

23           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24           The chair of the metropolitan King County council is authorized to enter into a  
25 contract amendment, substantially in the form attached, extending for the third and final  
26 year the existing contract with the Ferguson Group for federal government relations  
27 services in an amount not to exceed \$225,000 per year. The contract is for the services of  
28 representing the county before and monitoring actions by the United States Congress and  
29 the federal administration on issues of concern to King County, and to be an advocate on




