1 A MOTION authorizing an amendment to the interlocal
2 agreement previously executed between King County and
3 the King County cities in the Snoqualmie and South Fork
4 Skykomish Watersheds within Water Resource Inventory
5 Area (WRIA) 7.

8 WHEREAS, in February 2001, as authorized by King County Motion 11077,
9 King County and specific cities within the Snoqualmie and South Fork Skykomish
10 watersheds entered into an interlocal agreement in order to cooperatively address long-
11 term watershed planning and conservation issues, and

12 WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement establishes the Snoqualmie Watershed
13 Forum (“forum”), comprised of representatives of governments entering into the
14 interlocal agreement, as the governing body responsible for administering and
15 implementing the actions undertaken through the interlocal agreement, and

16 WHEREAS, council district 3 and council district 12 encompass area within the
17 watershed, and the interlocal agreement specifies that one ex-officio representative from

18 each district shall be appointed to the forum by King County and one ex-officio
19 representative shall be appointed by the Snoqualmie Valley Cities Association in order to
20 help broaden the geographic representation of the watershed, and

21 WHEREAS, in 2002 the council district boundaries were re-drawn, increasing the
22 area of district 3 within the watershed and decreasing the area of district 12 within the
23 watershed, and

24 WHEREAS, in response to the council district adjustment and to provide a more
25 flexible arrangement for the appointment of the forum ex-officio representatives, the
26 parties have identified the need to amend the interlocal agreement to provide for the
27 appointment of one ex-officio position from council district 3 and one ex-officio position
28 from either council district 3 or district 12, and

29 WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley Cities Association has changed its name to
30 the Snoqualmie Valley Governments Association in order to reflect representation by the
31 Snoqualmie Tribe, and the parties wish to amend the interlocal agreement to document
32 the name change;

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

34 The county executive is hereby authorized to execute the first amendment to the

35 interlocal agreement for the Snoqualmie and South Fork Skykomish watersheds within
36 Water Resource Inventory Area 7.



First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement for the Snoqualmie and South Fork Skykomish Watersheds within Water Resource Inventory Area 7

The Interlocal Agreement for the Snoqualmie and South Fork Skykomish Watersheds within Water Resource Inventory Area 7 was entered into by the County of King and the Cities of Duvall, Carnation, Snoqualmie and North Bend. This First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement addresses changes to the ex-officio membership of the Snoqualmie Watershed Forum, as desired by the parties to the Agreement.

This First Amendment is effective upon execution by all of the parties to the Agreement and may be executed in counterparts. The Agreement is hereby amended by substituting the text provided below for the identified section.

Section 4.2 is amended to read as follows:

In addition to the representatives of each of the parties, the Snoqualmie Watershed Forum shall also include three (3) non-voting, ex officio members to help broaden the geographic representation of the Snoqualmie Watershed Forum. One ex-officio member shall be appointed by the Snoqualmie Valley Government Association, and two shall be appointed by King County, one for Council District 3 and one for either Council District 3 or 12. Snoqualmie Watershed Forum members shall serve a term of four years, or the remainder of their elected term (if appropriate), whichever is shorter.
