32 Tuesdays of each month at 1:30 p.m., unless the council is meeting at that
33 time because the preceding Monday was a state or county holiday.

34 Labor, operations and technology committee:

35 The second and fourth Tuesday of each month at 9:30 a.m., unless the
36 committee of the whole is meeting at that time because the preceding
37 Monday was a state or county holiday.

38 Law, justice and human services committee:

39 First and third Thursdays of each month at 9:30 a.m.

41 First, second and third Thursday of each month at 1:30 p.m.




