



14	29.81A.020, authorize the publication and distribution of a local voters' pamphlet for

RESOLUTION #267

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Fire Commissioners of Duvall / Fire Protection District 45, King County, Washington, authorizing the publication and distribution of a local voters' pamphlet with a special election.

- WHEREAS, Duvall / King County Fire Protection District 45 have placed on the May 18th special election a ballot proposition asking whether or not the regular property tax levy of the District should be increased within the applicable statutory limits to \$1.50 per \$1,000 of true and assessed valuation; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes that it is in the best interests of its citizens to be informed of the potential effects of the restoration of the property tax levy; and
- WHEREAS, in order to best inform the citizenry of the District of the potential effects of the restoration of said property tax levy, the District should participate in a voters' pamphlet which may provide the necessary information as well as differing opinions on the subject.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, by the Duvall / King County Fire District 45 Board of Commissioners, that the King County Records and Elections Department is hereby requested to produce a voters' pamphlet for the May 18, 2004 special election; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that Duvall / King County Fire District 45 hereby agrees to financially participate in the production and delivery of the voters' pamphlet and have further participated in soliciting for proponents and opponents of said measure by advertising in the local newspaper.
