8 WHEREAS, the King County department of judicial administration ("DJA") is
9 conducting a statewide Elder Abuse Conference to train law enforcement and prosecutors
10 on recognizing and responding to elder abuse, and

11 WHEREAS, Pierce county's Violence Against Women Act ("VAWA") elder
12 abuse grant, an organization with no contractual obligations with King County, has a
13 vested interest in educating law enforcement on the serious issue of elder abuse, and

14 WHEREAS, the VAWA elder abuse grant voluntarily, without coercion or
15 inducement, wishes to donate one thousand dollars to the Elder Abuse Conference, and

16 WHEREAS, this donation will legitimately enhance the county's ability to serve
17 in the public's interest and the knowledge gained at the conference by attendees will
18 benefit the elderly throughout Washington state, and

19 WHEREAS, this donation is intended neither to influence a particular county
20 action, nor to affect the performance of official duties and responsibilities by the DJA
21 staff, and

22 WHEREAS, King County government is a charitable organization as defined by
23 the federal Internal Revenue Service and King County as an entity can accept gifts;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 The King County department of judicial administration is authorized to accept a



Motion 11983 was introduced on 8/16/2004 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 8/23/2004, by the following vote:


