1 A MOTION related to the transfer of retired vanpool vans 2 to nonprofit organizations and local governments to meet 3 the needs of low-income, elderly, disabled and young 4 county citizens. 5 6 7 WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its citizens to increase 8 mobility options and reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation, 9 and 10 WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to groups serving individuals with 11 limited resources and mobility options will support those goals and provide significant 12 public benefits, and 13 WHEREAS, high-quality passenger vans retaining substantial value and utility 14 are periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and 15 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred

retired vans to agencies serving low-income, elderly, disabled and young people, and

17	WHEREAS, the council provided for the transfer of twenty-seven additional vans
18	in the 2004 Metro transit division budget;
