Phillips, Dunn and Hague 1 A MOTION authorizing the chair of the council to extend 2 the contract for services with the Ferguson Group to 3 represent the county during the United States 109th 4 Congress, 2nd session. 5 6 7 WHEREAS, the county is a subdivision of the state of Washington, and 8 WHEREAS, the county's services, operations and finances are to a significant 9 extent controlled by the actions of the state and federal governments, and 10 WHEREAS, the actions of the United States Congress affect the county's 11 services, operations and finances, and 12 WHEREAS, the grants, proposals and actions of the federal executive branch 13 affect the delivery of services to the citizens of King County, and 14 WHEREAS, the attack on the United States of September 11, 2001, and the 15 subsequent efforts against terrorism have resulted in added expenses and demands on the 16 taxpayers of King County, and

17	WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of the county for the county to
18	have representation during the United States 109th Congress, 2nd session, on a broad
19	range of complex issues, and
20	WHEREAS, the Ferguson Group has successfully met and exceeded every
21	contractual requirement within the original contract with the county, and
22	WHEREAS, the Ferguson Group would provide the high level of expertise
23	needed to represent the county during the United States 109th Congress, 2nd session, and
24	WHEREAS, Motion 10651, Section III, as amended, and OR 1-020 requires the
25	council to authorize the council chair to sign contracts in excess of twenty-five thousand
26	dollars;
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
28	The chair of the metropolitan King County council is hereby authorized to extend
29	the contract with the Ferguson Group in an amount not to exceed two hundred and forty-
30	nine thousand dollars, for the following services:
31	A. Representing the county before and monitoring actions by the United States
32	109th Congress, 2nd session, and the federal administration, and

B. Advocating on the county's behalf on policy issues including but not limited to those contained in the county's adopted federal agenda.
