11	WHEREAS, the council designated the committee as the labor implementation
12	committee responsible for implementing labor policy, and
13	WHEREAS, the committee is charged with considering and making
14	recommendations on labor agreements and municipal services contracts, and
15	WHEREAS, the committee is also charged with considering and making policy
16	recommendations relating to information technology, cable communication and
17	telecommunications, and

18	WHEREAS, King County continues to experience shortfalls in its current expense
19	fund, and
20	WHEREAS, the committee has, therefore, developed a work plan for 2006 to
21	facilitate its review of policy options and development of policy recommendations to
22	assist in cost effective solutions to these continuing general fund financial problems, and
23	WHEREAS, the committee seeks to be fully transparent and accountable to the
24	public for its work program, and
25	WHEREAS, the committee seeks full council involvement in and support for its
26	work program;

Labor Policy Implementation

Goal: To review all labor agreements transmitted to Council to ensure their compliance with policies established by the labor policy committee and guidance provided by Council legislation.

Key Work Program Items:

- Hold a labor policy briefing;
- Recommend new or changes to existing labor policies that could be adopted or changed to be consistent with council goals and priorities;
- Review and approve the 2007-2008 Equal Employment Opportunity/Affirmative Action Plan;
- Review and act on approximately 20 proposed labor agreements; and
- Help shape the Labor Summit agenda.

Government Operations

Goal: Improve customer service, performance and efficiency of county departments.

Key Work Program Items:

- Make policy recommendations to improve county elections;
- Make policy recommendations to develop a countywide performance measurement system;
- Review and implementation of the King County International Airport Noise Reduction Plan Recommendations;
- Review the King County International Airport Master Plan;
- Review and approve the King County Health Reform Program Measurement and Evaluation Report; and
- Recommend approval of the County Auditor's work program for 2006.

Technology

Goal: Make policy recommendations to improve county-wide information technology planning, management and operations.

Key Work Program Items:

- Review and approve the King County Strategic Technology Plan (2006-2008);
- Review and approve a plan to reorganize county technology management and operations;
- Review and approve a plan on how to realize benefits from technology projects;
- Provide policy direction to guide a countywide electronic document management system; and
