| 10 | significant extent controlled by the laws of the state, and |
| 11 | WHEREAS, legislation passed by the Washington state Legislature often impacts |
| 12 | King County's services, operations and finances, and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of King County to have |
| 14 | representation during the legislative session on a broad range of complex issues, and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, based on a competitive bidding process conducted in 2007, Michael |
| 16 | E. Temple was selected to represent King County with state government officials; |
| 17 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: |

| 24 | August 29, 2009, for an amount not to exceed \$73,600 commencing with the date of |
| 25 | contract signature. |
