Ferguson and Lambert A MOTION requesting the executive to propose policies to 1 guide the development and use of electric vehicle charging 2 stations at county facilities. 3 4 WHEREAS, fossil fuel vehicles emit greenhouse gasses and contribute to global 5 climate change, and 6 WHEREAS, fossil fuels are limited in supply and eventually societies will 7 eventually need to find alternative fuels, and 8 WHEREAS new technologies are making electric vehicles economically feasible 9 to produce and own, and 10 WHEREAS, owners of electric vehicles will need charging stations where they 11 can recharge the batteries of their vehicles, and 12 WHEREAS, King County operates park and ride lots as well as other facilities 13 that could serve as electric vehicle charging stations, and 14 WHEREAS, King County agencies will incur costs to develop and operate 15 electric vehicle charging stations, and

17	WHEREAS, King County is in difficult financial circumstances and may need to
18	recover some or all of the costs of developing and operating charging stations, and
19	WHEREAS, there needs to be a policy framework for the development and
20	operation of electric vehicle charging stations;
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
22	The executive is requested to propose policies to guide the development and
23	operation of electric vehicle charging stations located on property owned or leased by
24	King County. The policies should, among other matters, consider the need for recovery

of costs to development and operate charging stations. The executive is requested to propose these policies in legislation transmitted to the council by October 1, 2009.
