1	A MOTION recognizing the county director of elections	
2	for achieving the status of Certified Election Administrator	
3	and requesting periodic reports regarding the director's	
4	maintenance of certification.	
5	WHEREAS, the voters of King County on November 4, 2008, approved a cha	rter
6	amendment making the position of county director of elections an elective office, and	
7	WHEREAS, the complexity of modern election systems makes it necessary fo	r
8	the county director of elections to possess certain technical and administrative	
9	qualifications and expertise in order to perform effectively in that role, and	
10	WHEREAS, the voters of King County on November 4, 2008, approved a char	rter
11	amendment allowing the county council to establish by ordinance additional	
12	qualifications for the office of director of elections, besides the charter requirement of	•
13	being at least twenty-one years old, a citizen of the United States and a resident and	
14	registered voter of King County, and	
15	WHEREAS, the county council by Ordinance 16302 established additional	
16	qualifications for the office of director of elections, including a requirement that "[n]o	
17	later than thirty months after having been elected or appointed to the office of election	.S
18	director, the director shall have earned the certification of elections administrator from	1

19	the Washington state Office of the Secretary of State, and shall meet all continuing
20	education requirements of the Secretary of State," and
21	WHEREAS, as demonstrated by the letter from the Washington Secretary of State
22	that is Attachment A to this motion, King County director of elections Sherril Huff has
23	obtained certification as a Certified Election Administrator, as required by Ordinance
24	16302, and
25	WHEREAS, once certified, election administrators are required, in order to
26	maintain their certification, to obtain eighteen hours of continuing education each year, as
27	provided in WAC 434-260-300;
28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
29	A. The council recognizes and congratulates King County director of elections
30	Sherril Huff for obtaining certification as a Certified Election Administrator, effective
31	from June 1, 2010, through December 31, 2010.
32	B. The council requests that the director of elections provide a written report to
33	the council no later than September 1 of each year, beginning in 2010, detailing the hours
34	of continuing education that the director has obtained, or plans to obtain, in order to
35	maintain certification through the following calendar year.
36	C. The council requests that the director of elections inform the council promptly
37	in writing of any extension or termination of the director's certification as a Certified
38	Election Administrator.
39	D. The reports referred to in subsections B. and C. of this motion shall be filed
40	electronically with the clerk of the council, who shall forward electronic copies to each

- 41 councilmember, to the council chief of staff and to the lead staff for the council's
- 42 government accountability and oversight committee or its successor.
