1 A MOTION related to the transfer of retired vanpool vans
2 to nonprofit organizations and local governments to meet
3 the needs of low-income, elderly, disabled and young
4 county citizens.

5 WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its citizens to increase
6 mobility options and reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation,
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to nonprofit agencies and local
9 governments serving individuals with limited resources and mobility options will support
10 those goals and provide significant public benefits, and

11 WHEREAS, high-quality passenger vans retaining value and utility are
12 periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and

13 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred
14 retired vans to agencies serving low-income, elderly, disabled and young people, and

15 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 4.56.100 states that "each year the transit division shall make
16 available retired passenger vans for exclusive use by nonprofit organizations or local
17 governments that are able to address the mobility needs of low-income, elderly or young
18 people or people with disabilities";

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 The transfer of a retired vanpool passenger van to each of the following agencies


