1           A MOTION approving the King County Strategic  
2           InformationTechnology Plan 2016-2018, which identifies  
3           technology objectives and strategies that provide clear  
4           direction and guidance for technology efforts and  
5           investments in King County.

6           WHEREAS, the department of information technology is required under K.C.C.  
7           2.16.0755.B.2.s. to produce an information technology strategic plan with annual  
8           updates for council approval, and

9           WHEREAS, a draft plan was developed with input from information technology  
10          governance bodies, business leaders and technology leaders, and

11          WHEREAS, the prior Strategic Information Technology Plan 2013-2015 saw  
12          significant completion as reported in the 2016 Strategic Technology Plan Update that was  
13          transmitted to the council on April 29, 2016, and

14          WHEREAS, the five major strategic themes and supporting content included in  
15          the plan were unanimously endorsed by the members of the strategic advisory council on  
16          March 31, 2016, and

17          WHEREAS, the plan demonstrates alignment and support for the King County  
18          Strategic Plan 2010-2014, which was updated by Motion 14317 in March 2015;

19          NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 A. The executive is requested to revise and expand Attachment A to:

21 1. Further develop the performance measures to assess progress in achieving the  
22 objectives of the strategic technology plan 2016-2018. Such measures shall be focused on  
23 assessing whether the intended internal service improvement or public benefit has been  
24 achieved;

25 2. Include objectives and performance measures related to improving  
26 countywide IT services, including successfully implementing technology projects such  
27 that the operational benefits of a project are realized; and

28 3. Provide information on the investments costs and potential challenges that  
29 will be involved in achieving each of the objectives identified in the Strategic  
30 Technology Plan.

31 B. The executive shall transmit a revised plan with the above revisions by April  
32 30, 2017 date, in the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with the clerk of the  
33 council, who shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all  
34 councilmembers, the council chief of staff, the policy staff director and the lead staff for  
35 the government accountability and oversight committee, or its successor.

36 C. The King County Strategic Information Technology Plan 2016-2018, which is

37 Attachment A to this motion, is hereby approved, contingent on the council receiving the  
38 plan revised in accordance with this motion.
