1                   A MOTION appointing a committee to write the voters'  
 2                   pamphlet statement for the November 3, 2020, general  
 3                   election regarding Ordinance 19125 proposing an  
 4                   amendment to the King County Charter to grant the office  
 5                   of law enforcement oversight subpoena powers; amending  
 6                   Section 265 of the King County Charter.

7                   WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of  
 8                   local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for elections held in  
 9                   King County, and

10                  WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction  
 11                  that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction  
 12                  shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the  
 13                  measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,  
 14                  and

15                  WHEREAS, Ordinance 19125 provides for the submission to the qualified  
 16                  electors of King County, at a special election to be held in conjunction with the general  
 17                  election on November 3, 2020, a proposition proposing an amendment to the King  
 18                  County Charter to grant the office of law enforcement oversight subpoena powers;  
 19                  amending Section 265 of the King County Charter;


