2 pamphlet statement for the November 3, 2020, general
3 election regarding Ordinance 19139 proposing an
4 amendment to the King County Charter to reestablish the
5 office of county sheriff as an executive appointed position
6 represented by the executive in collective bargaining with
7 department of public safety employees; amending Sections
8 350.20.40, 680.10 and 890 of the King County Charter and
9 repealing Sections 645 and 898 of the King County
10 Charter.

11 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of
12 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for elections held in
13 King County, and

14 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction
15 that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction
16 shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the
17 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,

19 WHEREAS, Ordinance 19139 provides for the submission to the qualified

20 electors of King County, at a special election to be held in conjunction with the general
21 election on November 3, 2020, a proposition proposing an amendment to the King
22 County Charter to reestablish the office of county sheriff as an executive appointed
23 position represented by the executive in collective bargaining with department of public
24 safety employees; amending Sections 350.20.40, 680.10 and 890 of the King County
25 Charter and repealing Sections 645 and 898 of the King County Charter;
